Few of them are the development of the portal of West Bengal Madrassah Board, Vikas Pedia under CDAC, Ministry of Communication and Information Technology, Govt. of India. IIIM was the State Nodal Agency of Vikas Pedia Portal in West Bengal.

From 2019, IIIM initiated its own Knowledge Dissemination System named "Bangla Worldwide". Bangla Worldwide is aimed at creating a dynamic and interactive online/offline digital platform to connect the vibrant, culturally-conscious Bengali populations and also people having keen interest in Bengali literature and culture spread over India, Bangladesh and many other countries across the globe.







This endeavour has been planned with the objective of projecting the multi-dimensional features of Bengali language, culture, commerce, literature, entrepreneurship, and the involvement and achievements of Bengalis in various spheres of human activity. Bangla Worldwide is a Global Platform for Bengali-speaking people not only for dissemination of knowledge and information about our language - based culture but also for creating and developing a multifaceted avenue for exchange of information, thoughts and ideas in different fields of human activity.
